

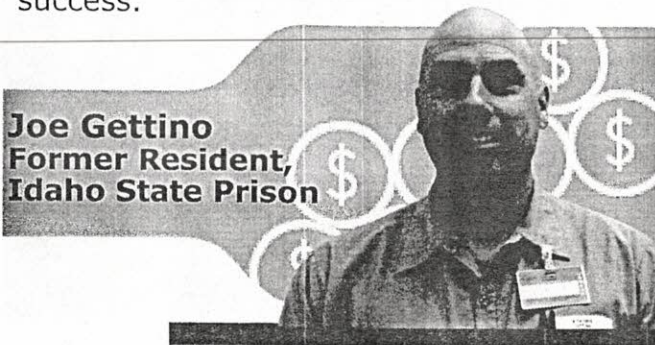
Testimonials

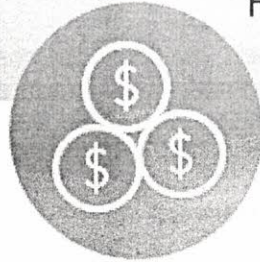

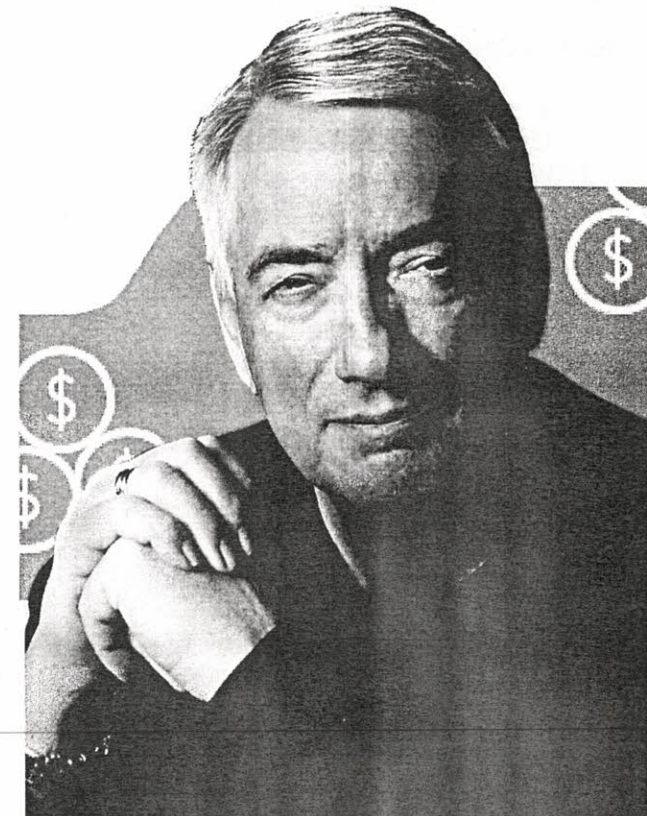
